National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) is a Mission mode programme of Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation (MOHUPA), Govt, of India for elimination of poverty in urban areas. The components includes Social Mobilisation and Institution Development (SM&ID), Capacity Building and Training (CB&T), Employment through Skill Training and Placement (EST&P), Self Employment Programme (SEP), Support to Urban Street Vendors (SUSV), Scheme for Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) and Innovative and Special Projects. This scheme is being implemented by the different Municipal Boards in the State.
